Brno, the historical centre of Moravia, is the second largest city in the Czech Republic, with a population of almost 400,000. The life and atmosphere of Brno is deeply influenced by its institutes of higher education. (Six public universities with their 80,000 students – the highest concentration of students in any city in the Czech Republic).

South Moravia, where Brno is located, is a flourishing region attractive to tourists. Besides its many important national monuments and wine routes which wend their way through a beautiful landscape, the region offers a great variety of leisure-time activities.



REASONABLE LIVING COSTS

As compared to other leading universities or Western European countries, the costs related to studying in the Czech Republic are relatively low. The estimate of the total annual costs of a student's life in Brno, including accommodation, meals etc., is 3,500–4,000 EUR.

INTRODUCTION COURSE

If you are an aspiring Doctor or Dentist, Masaryk University is here to guide you on your path to success. Our Foundation Programme provides a unique route to the Medicine or Dentistry programme. The first of its kind in the Czech Republic, the Foundation Programme is delivered by the very same academic staff that will be teaching you when you commence your studies in Medicine or Dentistry. It is designed for students who have the ability and aptitude to succeed as doctors or dentists but require a deeper knowledge in the sciences before commencing their pre-clinical studies.

The programme has proven itself to be a popular option with a diverse range of students. You may not have studied the basic sciences in your last two years of high school education, you may have been away from these subjects for a period or simply need to strengthen your existing knowledge. If this is the case, the Foundation Programme offers a pathway to your dream career whilst benefiting from competitive tuition fees and the chance to study and live in one of central Europe's most beautiful cities.

The programme lasts twenty weeks and you will experience twenty-five face to face teaching hours per week. In addition to the tuition in science, you will also start to learn Czech Language. This will put you at a distinct advantage when you start the Medicine or Dentistry course proper, as you will already have a head-start over those commencing their first year of tuition from fresh. The split of lectures and seminars, coupled with our student-centred approach, ensures you will have every opportunity to get the most from the programme.

At the end of the foundation you will take an exam assessing your knowledge of the course content you have studied. If you pass this final exam you are able to progress to the first year of your chosen programme in medicine or dentistry.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE



Applying for the Foundation programme is simple. Admission is open to all those that have completed or are completing their final year of high school education. Applications can be made FREE of charge using our online application form and uploading the following:

1. A current CV
2. Scanned copies of your final high school certificates

For those concluding their high school in the year of application you can indicate this on your application and CV and upload the certificates/transcripts you have.

Once your application has been assessed, your acceptance will be confirmed. Then you will be able to pay the tuition fee. Once you have paid the tuition fee your seat is secure and you will receive your official acceptance.



FEES AND OTHER COSTS

**The tuition fee is CZK 180,000.
This equates roughly €6 900.**

Coupled with the low cost of accommodation and living compared to most Western European cities, the programme is accessible for a large number of aspiring medical or dental students.
